

## Frequently Asked Questions about Summer Course

**1. What kind of student can apply for this school?**

All kinds of students all over the world with Higher Education can apply for this Summer Course. The Summer Course is on bachelor's level.

**2. Does the applicant need an IELTS Score and an interview to apply?**

No, not for this Summer Course.

**3. If students finish the Summer Course can they continue to study at RBS?**

Should they decide to study at RBS after the Summer Course, they need an IELTS Score and an interview.

**4. What type of visa is needed for this course?**

Summer Course students need a Tourist Visa and they can apply for this visa with the confirmation letter they will receive from us by registration.

**5. If students finish the Summer Course can they choose to return to their own country?**

Yes.

**6. Does the applicant need a NESO Certificate to apply?**

They need a NESO Certificate when they decide to study at Rotterdam Business School after Summer Course.

**7. Could you give any information about accommodation, food and also details regarding payment?**

We will arrange and pay for housing in a student hotel in the city of Rotterdam with breakfast. It is possible for the student to arrange packed lunch and dinner as well.

**8. Does this Summer Course give a commission to our company?**

No, your company will not receive any commission for the Summer Course.

**9. When does the Summer Course start?**

Start: 27 June for two weeks, Finish: 8 July.  
Start: 20 June for four weeks, Finish: 15 July.

**10. Is the Summer Course a preparation for the Rotterdam Business School?**

No.

**11. Are there any scholarships or discounts available for international partners?**

No, unfortunately there are no scholarships or discounts available.

**12. Are there any specific requirements need by the candidates taking part in the campaign? For example, level of English, age limit, academic background?**

All kinds of students can apply for this summer course, of course it is recommended that they can speak and understand English because the lessons are offered in the English language.

**13. Do you have a class/cultural activity schedule for the 2-week and 4-week Summer Course?**

Yes, we have, you can find it on the website, which will be completed at the end of March.

**14. Do you offer group discounts if we decide to send a group of students?**

There is a special group price for more than 5 students. Participation of 5 students or more can give you a 10% discount on the course price. With participation of 10 students or more you can send one person free of charge.

**15. If I send a teacher with the students, what housing costs would I have to expect for him or her?**

If the teacher will be staying in a single room, we have to ask for the price.

**16. Are all courses individually worth 6 ECTS?**

No, by participating in these courses you can earn up to 6 ECTS in total for the 4-week course and to 4 ECTS for the 2-week course.

**17. Is it possible to attend this programme as a Master student in the area of logistics management?**

Of course you can attend the Summer Course. We recommend you to take the 4-week course.

**18. If I already have a place to stay in Holland, is the Summer Course cheaper for me?**

In that case it cost € 800.- for two weeks and € 1,300.- for four weeks

**19. When do I have to pay for the Summer Course and when will I get the confirmation letter?**

The deadline for registration is early May. You will receive the confirmation letter and the account mid-May.

**20. Do I get a certificate at the end of the Summer Course?**

Yes, you will receive a certificate at the end of the Summer Course.

**21. What other costs do the students have to pay in addition to the costs of the course?**

They have to pay for their own living costs. The students need a health insurance that covers health costs abroad. If you don't have such insurance cover we can arrange one for you. The cost is € 40, -- per month. We can arrange it for 2 weeks, which will cost half of the monthly rate. **22. Do you suggest I read any books before coming to Holland?**

Basic Knowledge in Business is enough.

**23. When I've got my admission letter and have paid for the course, but somehow my visa is refused by the Embassy, will I get my money back and how long will that take?**

We will contact the Embassy and ask them what the problem is. If there is a problem and you cannot get a tourist visa you will get your money back on your bank account as soon as possible.

**24. Is it possible that we could write two addresses on the registration form? A current and a temporary address?**

Unfortunately it is not possible. We need your current address for registration and we don't send any post to you, only by e-mail. If you wish to receive private post at another address in Holland or somewhere else in the meantime, you have to arrange that by yourself.

**25. Regarding housing is this student hotel in the city of Rotterdam available before or after the 4-week or 2-week programme?**

If you need housing longer than the duration of the course you have to arrange it by yourself.
